


South Park

2018 Safety Improvements

In 2017, the South Park Public Safety Taskforce released a list of recommendations that included ways to make the South Park neighborhood safer for walking. The City of Seattle has scheduled improvements for 2018 based on those recommendations, and residents now have the opportunity to prioritize additional projects. Below is a map that shows both funded improvements and additional opportunities.

Crosswalk/Signal Improvements



① Updates to crosswalks on Cloverdale (12th and 8th) will include a larger crossing sign that counts down and a sound signal that alerts pedestrians when it is safe to cross.


★ Residents can prioritize similar upgrades for the crosswalk on Cloverdale and 7th for **\$25K**.

Radar Speed Signal



② A new sign on Cloverdale will alert drivers of their speed and help calm traffic.

New Pedestrian Lights



③ A new light will be installed by the SR 99 on-ramp to increase street visibility and safety.

★ Residents can prioritize more pedestrian lighting on Cloverdale east of SR 99 for **\$150K** or west of SR 99 for **\$150K**.

LED Lighting Upgrade



④ 8th Avenue street lights on Thistle, Rose, Southern and Monroe streets and the street light on 12th and Cloverdale will be converted to LED lights resulting in a brighter, more effectively lit road.

Underdeck Lighting Repair



⑤ Existing lights underneath the SR99 highway will be repaired.

Street Curb improvement



⑥ Barriers that separate the planting strip from the road will be placed on 5th from Cloverdale to Henderson and on 7th from Trenton to Henderson, providing people a safe distance from traffic and a barrier between the walkway and the road.


Trail Upgrades



⑦ Lights along the trail will be repaired and a plan to renovate the 8th Avenue trail is in development. Updates include new landscaping and repairs to the trail walkway.

★ Residents can prioritize more lighting along the trail for **\$350K**.

New Stairway Lighting



★ Residents can prioritize new lighting for the stairway located on 12th, south of Donovan for **\$150K** and/or the stairway located on 10th, south of Donovan for **\$150K**.

Sidewalk Widening



★ Residents can prioritize widening the sidewalk underneath SR 99 for **\$200K**. This creates more space for people to walk, and by reducing the width of the road on Cloverdale it will calm car traffic.
